Don't wait too long. Lime hardens quickly, requiring aggressive and dangerous chemicals to remove. Allowing lime to build up on windows impacts visibility, making it more dangerous for operators, as well as making it more difficult to remove as time goes on.

Don't create too much work. Excessive lime buildup often requires products containing corrosive acid to remove. This requires extensive PPE, containment apparatus, and safeguards to prevent accidental exposure.

WHAT TO DO:

Clean regularly: Regular preventative maintenance with safer products prevents bigger problems down the road, extending the life of the equipment.

Watch the paint: Harsh chemicals can etch painted surfaces and damage decals. Use products that effectively remove lime without hurting the finish.

Care for the environment: Use products that are non-toxic, safe on vegetation, and are not considered hazardous.
